### **Vision and Hearing Testing Scheduled for October 7, 8, 9**

The Vision, Hearing, Acanthosis Nigricans and Spinal Screening Program, Chapter 36 of the Health and Safety Code, requires children enrolled in public, private or parochial schools in Texas be provided with a screening each year. ACS is scheduled to screen on Wednesday and Thursday, October 7 and 8, for the students on the Primary Campus and October 9 for the Elementary Campus students. All four year old students, as well as Kindergarten, First Grade, Third Grade, and Fifth Grade students, along with any new student to the school, will be tested. **Parents who wish their child NOT to participate in this process need to notify the office and turn in a copy of a professional examination not later than Friday, October 2, 2009.** Please contact either campus office for additional information.
